

KVK specialists visited MGMG village

As per the instruction by the ICAR, Krishi Vigyan Kendra Hailakandi (ICAR Research Complex for NEH Region) implementing various programme at the Dholai part VI, under Katlicherra Development block of Hailakandi District, adopted under the Programme “*Mera Gaon Mera Gaurav*”. Since its adoption, KVK is trying to provide necessary guidance, technological backup on agriculture and allied enterprises in the village.

As a part of this KVK specialists namely Mr. Saurabh Sarma (SMS, Plant Protection), Mr. A.D. Deepak Misra (SMS, Horticulture) and Mrs. Kabita C. Sarma (Programme Assistant, Food Science/ Home Science) has visited Dholai part VI village (adopted under MGMG programme) and discussed various topics with the farmers. Discussion on various issues *viz.*, insect pest and disease management in areca nut, snail management, demonstration on installation of funnel pheromone trap, cultivation practices of areca nut and other seasonal vegetables, value addition of different local fruits, employment generation through flower making etc. were done among the farmers. Apart from this, KVK staff has also visited areca nut (var. Kahikuchi Selection) demonstration plot in the farmers’ field to diagnose problem, if any, and advised the farmer for betterment of the crop.
